

ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT ^{1,3}

- Provide Administrative Support: answer phone calls, sort mail, maintain databases, filing, etc.

HOUSE DINNERS & ACTIVITY ¹

- Prepare a meal and host a short activity for Monday or Thursday night house dinner*

MAINTENANCE PROJECTS ¹

- Exterior: plant flowers, landscaping, maintain lawn/shrubs, snow removal**
- Interior: deep-cleaning projects, painting projects, and small household repairs**
- Bedroom Beautification: sponsor individual bedrooms to redecorate for new ladies *
- Vehicle Maintenance: assist with basic upkeep, car washes and oil changes*
- Transport large furniture and supplies for the house*
- Organize donated items in food pantries and hygiene banks*
- Maintain on-site boutique (clothing bank)*
- Solicit on-going donations of household supplies through current Needs List*

MENTORING RELATIONSHIPS ^{1,2,3}

- Engage in a one-on-one personal mentoring relationship

ORGANIZATIONAL DEVELOPMENT SUPPORT ^{1,3}

- Plan a fundraiser /"friend-raiser," host a pitch party to raise awareness
- Serve as a liaison between Street's Hope and your church/community group
- Assist with grant research & writing
- Update social media sites, maintain website

SOCIAL/COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES ¹

- Facilitate a craft, game or hobby night *
- Plan an outing/social activity for residents* (i.e. bowling, movies, hiking)
- Plan and host a holiday party or birthday party for residents*
- Help set up, clean up, or prepare food for a special event* (i.e. Client Celebration)

SPIRITUAL/FAITH BASED ACTIVITIES ¹

- Lead a group Bible study (one time or ongoing)*
- Host praise and worship time (musical)*
- Plan and host a spiritual development retreat*

WEEKLY TRANSPORTATION ^{1,2,3}

- Assist with individual client transportation to/from appointments (medical, legal, etc.)
