Resident Contact Assignments

WEEKLY TRANSPORTATION (HIGHEST NEED) ^{1,2,3}

- Assist with individual client transportation to/from appointments (medical, legal, etc.)

SOCIAL/COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES ¹

- Facilitate a game or hobby night Thursday or Saturday*
- Plan an outing/social activity for residents* (i.e. bowling, movies, outdoor activities)
- Plan and host a holiday or birthday party for residents*
- Help set up, clean up, or prepare food for a special event* (i.e. Client Celebration)

HOUSE DINNERS & ACTIVITY ¹

- Prepare a meal and host a short activity for Monday night house dinner*

MENTORING RELATIONSHIPS ^{1,2,3}

- Engage in a one-on-one personal mentoring relationship

KEY:

1= Training/direction will be offered

2= Background check required

3= Long term commitment of 6mo-1year

*= Ideal for an individual or small group (<5 volunteers)

**= Ideal for a small or large group (<15 volunteers)

Volunteers must attend all 4 Partner Training sessions before becoming an active volunteer.

MAINTENANCE PROJECTS ¹

- Exterior: plant flowers, landscaping, maintain lawn/shrubs, snow removal**
- Interior: deep-cleaning projects, painting projects, and small household repairs**
- Bedroom Beautification: sponsor individual bedrooms to redecorate for new ladies *
- Vehicle Maintenance: assist with basic upkeep, car washes and oil changes*
- Transport large furniture and supplies for the house*
- Organize donated items in food pantries and hygiene banks*
- Maintain on-site boutique (clothing bank)*
- Solicit on-going donations of household supplies through current Needs List*

ORGANIZATIONAL DEVELOPMENT SUPPORT ^{1,3}

- Plan a fundraiser /"friend-raiser," host a pitch party to raise awareness
